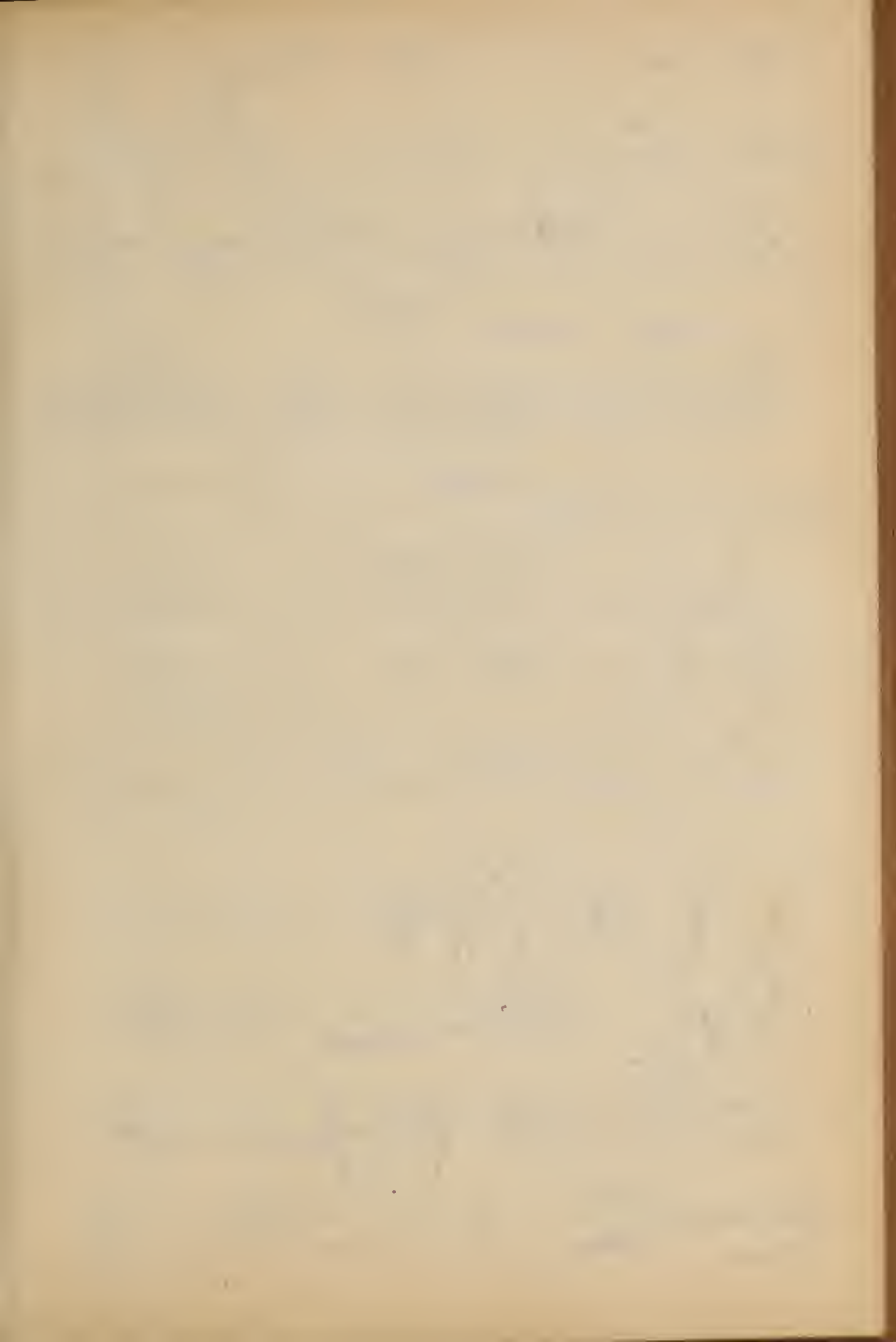

They administered chloroform eight times, injected morphia twice with the second injection. I fell asleep at midnight Dr. P. left, while John slept in Nan's salita. The rest of the night had sleep. Jan 24. Was very weak - cold perspiration all over body. John seemed anxious. Many friends, hearing of the return of illness, called continual nausea.

Jan. 25. Still very weak. no appetite. Pain ceased in the arm but distressing hiccoughs set in and continued with occasional interruptions all day. Iced milk palatable.

Jan 26. Hiccoughs continued all last night and all to day. Dr. Cooper called with John. Dr. C. suggested chloroform

with whiskey taken inwardly would check
it - had no effect. Have got from Dr.
Page receipt of musk for Wiccough - seemed
to give a little relief but it continued.

Jan. 27. Sunday. Somen arrived early,
proposed some remedies but Jack did
not agree. He bought several books with
him. John gave calomel 2 days in
cession. Wiccough still continuing

Jan. 28. Monday. No pain in heart
while under the calomel. Wiccough's
stopped.

Kind enquiries made every hour
from all quarters, rich & poor -
Allowed to see nobody.

Tuesday, 29. Removed to Annie's
room. Page sent claret wine. Took it
twice. Find John does not favor it.
Says nothing tonic is now admissible
as it brings back pressure. Two attacks

Jan. 30th Wednesday. Last night troubled
from 10 P. M. to 3 A. M. John gave all
