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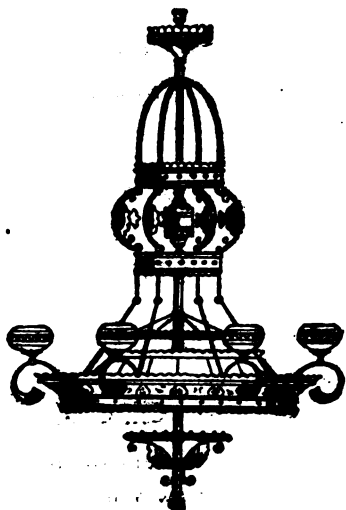
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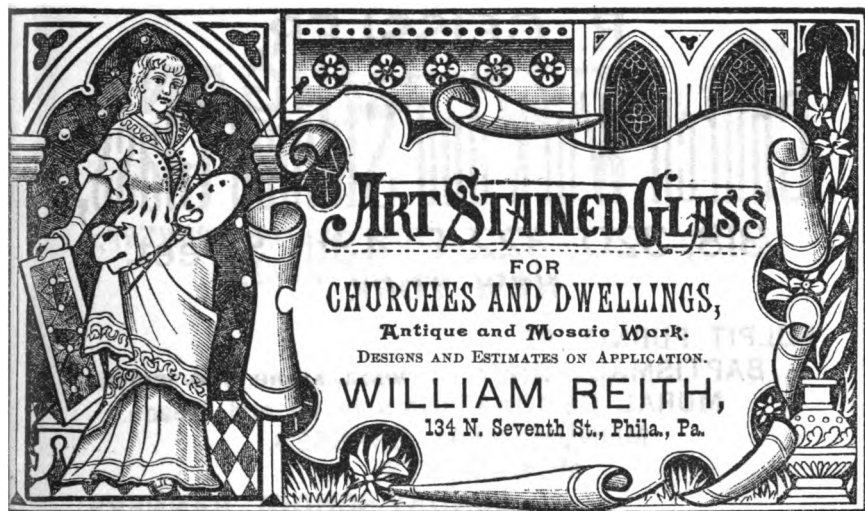

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MODERATOR ROBERTS.

REV. William C. Roberts, D. D., LL.D., whose portrait we give in the Hand-book, is the present Moderator of the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in the United States of America. He is also the President of Lake Forest University, Chicago, Ill.

He was born September 23d, 1832, in Cardiganshire, South Wales, and came with his parents to this country in 1849.

He graduated from Princeton College in 1855, and from the Theological Seminary in 1858.

His first church was the First Presbyterian, Wilmington, Del. From thence he was called, in the fall of 1861, to the First Church of Columbus, O. In 1864 he removed to Elizabeth, N. J., and became co-pastor with Rev. Dr. Magie. Two years later he organized the Westminster Church of Elizabeth. After a very successful pastorate of five years in this church, he was elected in 1881 Corresponding Secretary of the Board of Home Missions of the Presbyterian Church. After serving in this position with great ability for six years, he was induced by most flattering offers to take charge of the prosperous institution over which he now presides.

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

THE General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in the United States of America will meet, agreeably to appointment, in the First Presbyterian Church, in Saratoga Springs, N. Y., Thursday, May 15th, 1890.

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Letters relating to missionary appointments and other operations of the Board should be addressed to the Corresponding Secretaries.

Letters relating to the pecuniary affairs of the Board or containing remittances of money should be sent to O. D. Eaton, Treasurer.

At the close of the last year the Board had in commission under it 1592 missionaries, over 900 of whom were west of the Mississippi. The largest number in any one State was in Kansas, 147.

Its permanent funds amount to \$268,200.

There was expended by it the last fiscal year \$860,128.

Ordinarily appropriations are granted by the Board, upon the recommendation of the Presbytery. Whether to do so or not, however, is discretionary with the Board. (See minutes 1883, page 644.)

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Certificates of honorary membership are given on receipt of thirty dollars and of honorary directorship on receipt of \$100.

Persons sending packages for shipment to missionaries should state the *contents* and *value*. There are no specified days for shipping goods. Send packages to the Mission-House *as soon as they are ready*. Address the Treasurer of the Board of Foreign Missions, No. 53 Fifth Avenue, New York, N. Y.

The postage on letters to all our mission stations is five cents per each half ounce or fraction thereof.

At the close of the last year the Board had as workers under it about 1741 missionaries in 34 mission fields.

Its expenditures amounted to \$932,893.57.

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The object of this Board is to raise and distribute scholarships to worthy young men, of approved character and ability, who study for the ministry, and who have not sufficient funds of their own with which to obtain the necessary education. One hundred and fifty dollars per year is the largest scholarship allowed.

No candidate is received by the Board who has not been a member of the Presbyterian Church, or of some closely-related body, for at least one year; who has not been recommended to the Presbytery by the Session of the Church of which he is a member; and who is not sufficiently advanced in study to enter college, except in extraordinary cases.

Last year 772 candidates were assisted by the Board. For this purpose about \$90,000 was contributed to it.

How largely the Board of Education is concerned in the preparation of a ministry for the Church is seen in the fact that of the 6000 ministers on her roll, 2400 have been aided by the Board to reach the ministry.

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All manuscripts for Sabbath-school library-books, also all matter offered for the *Westminster Teacher* and the other periodicals, and all letters concerning the same, to the Rev. J. R. Miller, D. D., Editorial Superintendent.

Business correspondence and orders for books and periodicals, except from Sabbath-school missionaries, to John A. Black, Business Superintendent.

Remittances of money and contributions to the Rev. C. T. McMullin, Treasurer.

The capital stock at last report amounted to \$506,481.04. Much of it is unproductive.

The net profits of the last year were \$6692.

The receipts into the Treasury from all sources were \$337,781.87.

There was contributed by the Churches and Sabbath-schools for Sabbath-school and Missionary Work about \$66,000.

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It aids only the really weak—the average grant has been \$521; and the maximum appropriation \$1000.

It stimulates the congregation to do its best—never giving more than one-third of the cost, and not that until the other two-thirds are actually collected.

In every case it holds a mortgage bearing no interest, and due only when the building ceases to be a Presbyterian house of worship. It carries, also, policies of insurance for the amount invested.

Two hundred and fifty churches were aided last year, and the aggregate amount of appropriations was \$128,871.55.

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The object of this Board is to aid such aged or disabled ministers of the Church or their families as are unable to support, comfortably, themselves.

1. Only members of Presbyteries in connection with the General Assembly, and the families of those who were at their death in such connection, are entitled to aid.*

2. All appropriations must be made on the recommendation of that Presbytery, or of a Standing Committee of that Presbytery, to which the applicant, if a minister, belongs; if the application be for a widow or orphan children, it may be made by the Presbytery within whose bounds the family resides, or by the Presbytery with which the minister was connected at the time of his death. The same rule applies to the renewal of recommendations, if aid is continued.

*The General Assembly, in 1885, directed that "women who have given themselves to the Missionary Work," and, in 1889, that "lay Missionaries, commissioned by the Foreign Board," should also "be placed on the roll for the benefactions of this Board, upon the same conditions as ministers."

The number to whom remittances were sent the past year was as follows: Ministers, 223; widows of ministers, 341; orphan families, 31. The amount was \$123,019.11.

The Permanent Fund of the Board amounts to \$417,960.05.

The Centenary Fund raised for its work, but not yet transferred to it, amounts, with accrued interest, to about \$630,000.

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290 missionaries are under the employ of the Board.

\$100,000 was contributed to its work by churches, Sabbath-schools, and women's societies last year.

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The treasury of the Board received last year \$45,445.94. In addition to this the institutions under the care of the Board received directly from churches and individuals \$45,350.20, making an aggregate of \$68,069.61.

The following terms of admission prescribed at Princeton are, to a greater or less degree, the requirements of all or most of the above institutions:—

Every person applying for admission into the Seminary must produce satisfactory written testimonials that he possesses good natural talents, and is of a prudent and discreet deportment; that he is in full communion with some regular church; and that he has passed through a regular course of collegiate

study, or, wanting this, he must submit himself to an examination in regard to the branches of literature usually taught in such a course.

Those who are not graduates of any college must, prior to matriculation, produce a certificate from their Presbytery, or the ecclesiastical body under whose care they are as candidates for the gospel ministry, expressing its approval of their entrance upon theological study, without further literary preparation.

When a student has been received under the care of a Presbytery, and has passed his examination on the studies usually pursued in college with approbation, a certificate from the Presbytery declaring this fact is received as sufficient to answer every requisition in regard to testimonials.

When a student who has been connected with any other theological seminary seeks admission into this, he must produce testimonials of his good standing and regular dismissal, before he can be received.

A knowledge of Hebrew is not essential to students entering the Junior Class, inasmuch as the rudiments of this language form part of the regular course of instruction given in the first year. But a previous acquaintance with at least the written character would be of great service to beginners.

MEETING OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, 1890.

The One Hundred and Second General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in the United States of America will meet in the First Presbyterian Church of Saratoga Springs, of which Rev. Perry S. Allen is pastor, May 15th, 1890, at 11 o'clock A. M.

It will be opened with a sermon by Rev. Wm. C. Roberts, D. D., LL. D., President of Lake Forest University, Chicago, Ill., and Moderator of the last General Assembly.

After the organization of the body and the election of permanent officers, the report of the Committee of Arrangements, recommending hours for the sessions of the body and the order of popular evening services, will be heard.

The Committee consists of Revs. Perry S. Allen, Wm. H. Roberts, D. D., James N. Crocker, Charles F. Dowd, James Eells. Ruling Elders, C. C. Lester, Edward N. Jones, E. D. Selden.

The following order is observed by the Assembly in reference to certain devotions and causes:—

1. The Lord's Supper is to be celebrated by the Assembly on the evening of Thursday, the first day of its sessions.

2. The evenings of the days of session are assigned to popular meetings in the following order:—

The evening of Friday, the second day, to the Board of Publication and the Sabbath-school interests of the Church.

The evening of Wednesday, the sixth day, to the Foreign Mission Work.

The evening of Friday, the eighth day, to the cause of Temperance.

The following is the rule of representation for the General Assembly:—

Each Presbytery consisting of not more than 24 ministers, shall send 1 minister and 1 elder; and each Presbytery consisting of more than 24 ministers, shall send 1 minister and 1 elder for each additional 24 ministers, or for each additional fractional number of ministers not less than 12.

A Presbytery cannot be formed of less than 5 ministers.

DELIVERANCE OF THE LAST ASSEMBLY ON TEMPERANCE.

That we earnestly recommend to the ministers and congregations in our connection, and to all others, to persevere in vigorous efforts until laws shall be enacted in every State and Territory of our beloved country, prohibiting entirely a traffic which is the principal cause of the drunkenness and its consequent pauperism, crime, taxation, lamentation, war, and ruin to the bodies and souls of men, with which the country has so long been afflicted.

MINISTERIAL RELIEF BY CONTRACT, FOUNDED ON THE LAW OF EXPECTATION OF LIFE.

THIS way of help was chartered, organized, and put in charge of ministers and elders recommended for it by the Synods of 1756-1759, recommending, also, a representative care for it of their respective Presbyteries, which would be likely to improve, as well as advertise and certify, the work thus being done.

That representative care subsequently failed with the growing number of Presbyteries, especially in this century, and it is now again proposed, within the last two years, from our representative or larger Synods. Those of Pennsylvania, Ohio, Indiana, and Illinois have already appointed two ministers or elders respectively, who have been chosen into the corporation with this in view. Six others, those of New York, New Jersey, Baltimore, Minnesota, Missouri, and Wisconsin, have appointed a committee to report on the propriety of doing so at their next stated meeting. Forty-five Presbyteries, also, representing fourteen States, have volunteered a committee of one or

more to be in correspondence with it, and report from time to time.

It is, of course, to be regretted that some such change as this had not been made before. Yet, being made, we may be glad of this, that it is finding favor so extensively and fully, and in so short a time. We may be sure, also, of its results for good, not merely for the ministry it aims especially to serve, with their surviving families and friends, but for the Church at large.

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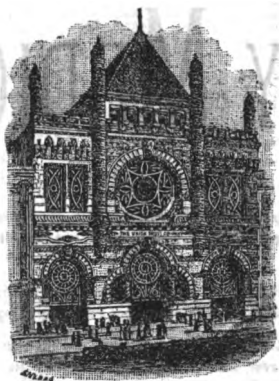

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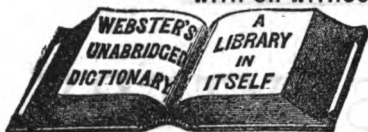

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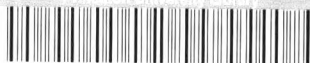
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
